Play your part, stay apart

We kindly ask that you play your part and respect other people's space when visiting Culver Square and shopping in our stores. We have implemented a one-way system on entering the shopping centre to help with the social distancing. We ask that you follow the signage on entering and inside the centre.



Has the cleaning of the centre been increased?

Yes, an enhanced cleaning pattern has been implemented to ensure that the centre is regularly cleaned.



Are the toilets open?

Yes, the toilets are open however we have implemented social distancing measures inside the toilets. We have provided hot water and soap so that you are able to clean your hands.



Are there any additional hand sanitiser stations in the centre?

Yes, we have installed hand sanitisers at the entrance to the centre. In addition, each store will also have hand sanitisers before you enter.



Is there a limit on the number of people that can be in the centre at one time?



We will closely monitor the number people in the centre and if we feel the numbers are too high for you to safely social distance, we may temporarily close the entrances to the centre.

Can we use the bins in the centre?

Yes, the bins are still available to use and are being cleaned regularly.
