We will closely monitor the number people in the centre and if we feel the numbers are too high for you to safely social distance, we may temporarily close the entrances to the centre.

Will there be public seating in the centre?

Yes, but the number of seats has been reduced to allow social distancing. As the seating is limited if someone else has a greater need than you please be kind enough to give up your seat.



Do I have to wear a facemask in the centre?



In accordance with government guidelines, you are required to wear a face covering in all shops in our shopping centre. If you choose not to wear one any of the retailers are within their rights to refuse you entry into their shop. We will be adhering to the guidelines issued by the government on those that do not need to wear face coverings.
